Questions & Answers**Bexar County Junior Livestock Show**

- Q. What is the eligibility to exhibit in the County Livestock Show.
 A. You must be 8 yrs. old and have entered the third (3rd) grade by September 1 of the current year. Must be enrolled and regularly attending

a public or private school of a Bexar County school district or be a permanent resident of Bexar County during the time of the show and have continuously, personally fed and cared for their animal(s) throughout the entire feeding period.

No one who has graduated from high school will be eligible to exhibit. No one will be eligible to show in the BCJLS if they show in any surrounding junior county shows, where school districts overlap into adjoining counties, that hold an auction sale within the same calendar year, with the exception of the major shows. Our neighboring counties have this same rule in effect for their county shows.

San Antonio Livestock Show

REMINDER....No Pass, No Show, if you are academically ineligible your livestock projects are ineligible as well.
