CAREER AWARENESS & YOUTH LEADERSHIP LAB

CAYLL is an educational activity for youth 14-19 years of age, conducted by the Cooperative Extension Program at Prairie View A&M University. The program is designed to provide experiential learning opportunities that reinforce the importance of education, improve employability skills and explore careers in a non-formal setting. Youth will participate in career workshops that will focus primarily on agricultural and food sciences, communications, information technology and entrepreneurship.

EXPERIENCE CAMPUS LIVING

Youth will engage in social and life skills seminars as well as experience dormitory style living in a college environment. Participants spend three days and two nights on the Campus of Prairie View A&M University and explore campus living first hand.

EXPERIENCE LEADERSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

Each year participants are selected to serve on program and assist with educational events and sessions. This event provides youth the opportunity to display their leadership skills by taking on leadership roles in certain activities provided throughout the program.

WHAT DOES IT COST?

The cost to attend CAYLL is \$100.00 per participant. However, 4-H provides 25 scholarship on a 1st come first serve basis, so turn your CAYLL Registration forms in today! Transportation is also provided the 4-H program
