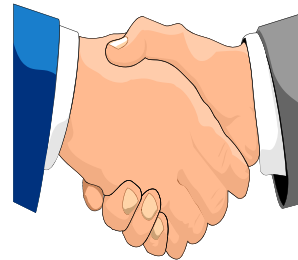


CEP Collaborations & Community Partnerships
