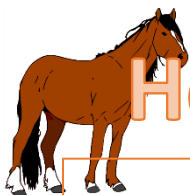

#### Eligibility:

1. Must be a Bexar County 4-H or Bexar County FFA member in good standing.
2. Must have exhibited at the BCJLS the (2) previous years and be entered in this year's show.
3. Please provide records showing previous 2 years participation.
4. Be a current year graduating senior.
5. Recipient must attend college in the fall semester of 2022.

#### Rules & Application:

The BCJLS will award, to qualifying applicants up to twelve (12) **\$500.00** scholarships at the 59<sup>th</sup> Annual Auction of Champions. Applicant must be present at the Auction of Champions to receive scholarship. Completed applications must be submitted to: **BCJLS – Scholarship P.O Box 1193 Adkins, TX 78101** Completed applications must be received or postmarked no later than **November 15, 2021**. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to ensure the application is postmarked correctly. Applications must be typewritten or computer generated except for required signatures.
