
<u> Land Stewardship Ambassador Application OPEN – Closes Nov. 1, 2021</u>

- Information: The Witte Museum has partnered with East Foundation to deploy our fourth cohort of Land Stewardship Ambassadors. This is a 10-week program which will raise awareness of land stewardship principles, promote civic engagement and inspire students to obtain careers that support land stewardship. Through interactive experiences, career exploration and the study of stewardship, the Land Stewardship Ambassadors Program (LSA) teaches students how to be a voice for Texas.
