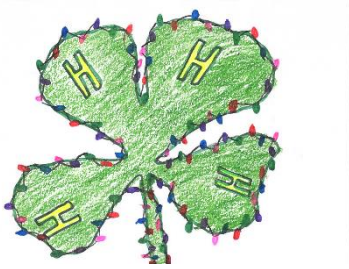

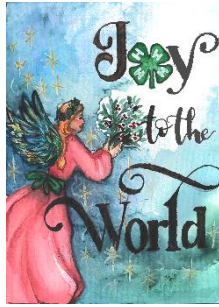

The coach certification training is mandatory for adults leading the 4-H Hunting Project and working with youth in live fire activities using archery, shotgun, rifle, and muzzleloading equipment. This training and certification will cover a leader in the Hunting Project and is not a substitute for any 4-H Shooting Sports discipline training/certification. Participants in the training will also be certified as Texas Parks and Wildlife Department Hunter Education Instructors. This certification will allow them access to a great set of free teaching resources and the ability to certify their 4-H members in Hunter Education anytime during the year. The training is open to 4-H volunteer leaders, Senior division 4-H members desiring to be assistant leaders, and County Extension Agents. Registration will be open on [4-H Online](#) individually for each training location:

The training is hands on and will include live fire of all related shooting equipment and hunting topics in basic hunting skills, firearm and outdoor safety, game biology, hunting equipment and maintenance, how to teach hunting, teaching resources and locating equipment, hunting laws and regulations, outdoor ethics, and wildlife and habitat management and conservation. The description is outlined within the rules. Remaining the same as in years past, members may still only enter 1 photo per category, max 15 photos.

Also, photos qualify directly from county to state for this contest. District contests have no bearing on qualifying for the state contest. Senior members (grades 9-12th) must place first at the COUNTY level to compete at state. State level participants will register and pay for entries on 4HOnline and then upload their photos on Submittable, which is the platform we use to manage the judging process.
