Club Chartering Process & Instructions – (TURN IN ASAP)

ALL 4-H Clubs Must Have:

- **Charter Application Worksheet** for Club/Group Managers to complete and use to fill out information in 4HOnline - This form is simply a worksheet and **should not be uploaded** as part of the chartering process.
- **2022-2023 Charter Agreement (Must be signed by CEA/CED)**
- **Bylaws:** The **sample bylaws are developed to serve as a guide** for clubs/groups to use in bylaw development and/or revision. **Chartered clubs/groups have flexibility with their bylaws; however, the items in bold in the sample set are required to be in all bylaws.** When you review the sample bylaws, you will notice **fewer bolded/required items**. This does not mean you have to change your bylaws, as long as they meet the minimum requirements, which they should if they were in compliance last year. Club/group bylaws may also not conflict with the Texas 4-H Rules and Guidelines and/or the charter agreement.

ONLY CLUBS with a 4-H BANK ACCOUNT MUST HAVE:

- **2021-2022 Financial Review Form & Asset List**
- **One Copy of Previous Bank Statement for each account:** Bank statements uploaded as part of the chartering packet should **not include copies of canceled checks**. This is for security of the club/group account(s).

Some things to be aware of: The Club name MUST match what we have file in our current system to a TEE. If they alter the name/abbreviate or change up their name in any of the documents above, it will be rejected. Please double, and triple check that the signatures of reviewers on the financial review form are NOT club members of the club. They must be outside parties who sign that form.

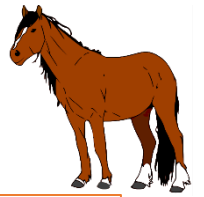

2022 District 12 4-H Shooting Sports Coach’s Certification Training – September 24th-25th (FLYER)

The next District 12 4-H Shooting Sports Coach’s Certification training has been scheduled for **September 24-25, 2022** at the Frio County Office of Texas A&M AgriLife Extension in Pearsall, Texas. This event is open to any/all **registered and screened 4-H volunteers** (age 21 and older) wishing to become certified to lead a 4-H shooting sports program in one of the following four disciplines: **Rifle, Pistol, Shotgun, or Archery**. **This training is open statewide**. There are three **opportunities** for attending this training with specific registration fees for each. The attendee registration options include:

- **Coach (Adult)** – Adults age 21 and older will be candidates for Certified Coach. **\$150**
- **Coach’s Assistant (Adult)** – Adults age 18-20 will be candidates for Coach’s Assistant. **\$150**
- **Coach’s Assistant (Youth)** – Youth age 14-18 will be candidates for Coach’s Assistant. **\$150**
 - Must be accompanied by a sponsoring adult (age 21 & over) and meet one of the following:
 - Sponsoring adult must be previously certified in that discipline and pay a reduced fee. **\$75**
This adult *will not receive any type of certification*.
 - Sponsoring adult may be registered above as **Coach (Adult)** and pay the registration fee. **\$150**.
 - Both must be in the same discipline/certification group.

4-H Entomology Club (STUDY SCHEDULE)

For those who are looking for additional entomology opportunities, the 4-H year is coming up! 4-H offers three Entomology Contests:

- 1 – Insect Identification Contest – competition held in late November/early December in Kerrville (high schoolers can also compete at state level in June)
- 2 – Insect Collection Contest – June
- 3 – Insect Photography Contest – June

In order to help those interested in the Identification Contest, I hold monthly practices to study the insects that are covered on that contest. The practices are virtual, I try to do in person when I can, but many 4-Hers attend from outside Bexar County, so this allows me to be more inclusive. During practices we study how to identify the insects on the contest and various things about them: Order name, common name, mouthpart type, lifecycle, habitat, pest status, and interesting facts you might be asked. For examples praying mantis: Mantodea, praying mantis, mandibulate/chewing, incomplete/hemimtabolous, beneficial, catch and wait predator. 4-H is for grades 3-12. Unfortunately, there isn't a competition for younger grades. Elementary are Juniors, Middle schoolers are Intermediates, and High schoolers are Seniors. You compete within your age group. There will also be a service-learning activity where campers will be asked to provide items to donate but will be taken a step further where they will be actively involved in preparing kits to be donated to a local organization, so they get a better understanding of why they brought items to the Center. More detail to come soon including Registration information, but we wanted to share the new vision for the camp with you so you could start promoting it with your 4-H members and their families.
