2023 Walter Gerlach Livestock Show and Sale – January 20th – 28th (RULEBOOK)

Eligibility Rules (see Rule 15 of rulebook):

- Exhibitors must be an active member of an "invited" FFA Chapter or 4H Club (ASTA FFA, Helotes 4H LSO, LSP, and Unlimited Clubs, and Leon Springs 4H) and must reside in the Northside ISD or legally attend a NISD school during the entire feeding period and throughout the duration of the show. (See Rule 12 for animal eligibility).
- Exhibitor must attend an accredited private, home school, or public elementary or secondary school and has not yet graduated from high school (in the Northside school district boundaries)
- Exhibitor must personally feed and care for his/her animal for the entire duration of the feeding and fitting period.
- An exhibitor attending the NISD Alternative Center may not participate.
- An exhibitor who is a 5th year high school student may not participate.
- All exhibitors must be between the ages of 9 and 19 on August 31, 2022 or may be 8 years old and in 3rd grade on August 31, 2022.
- Exhibitors who are ineligible under Texas Education Code 33.081 "No Pass, No Play" are not allowed to participate in any WGLS activity, including the showing of a project and/or auction. Any project owned by an ineligible exhibitor is also ineligible for competition and auction. This includes Ag Mechanics entries.


