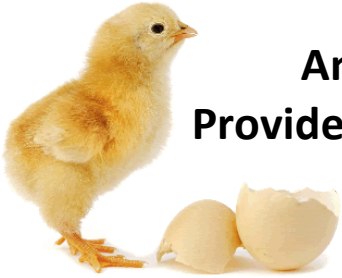
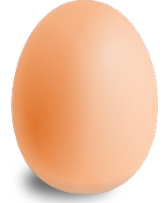

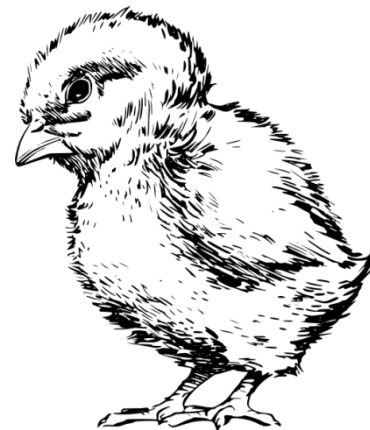


SPOTS ARE OPEN NOW, FOR THE SPRING SEMESTER!
