# General Rules & Guidelines

---

## WHAT IS DISTRICT 10 4-H ROUNDUP?

The District 10 4-H Roundup event is held twice a year (Fall & Spring) to allow 4-H members to showcase their knowledge and talents in various 4-H contests. District 10 4-H members of all age divisions are welcome to compete in any of the contests offered (granted they meet the criteria of the event). The following rules below apply to all Fall Roundup District contests, unless otherwise stated in the contest's specific rules.

## MEMBERSHIP & AGE DIVISIONS

1. Participants must be 4-H members currently enrolled on 4HOnline and belong to a Texas 4-H Youth Development County program.
2. There are three age divisions for competition as outlined below. 4-H members' division is determined by their grade level as of August 31, 2023.
  - a. Junior- 3<sup>rd</sup> (and 8 yrs. old), 4th & 5th
  - b. Intermediate- Grades 6th, 7th, & 8th
  - c. Senior- Grades 9th, 10th, 11th & 12<sup>th</sup> (and not surpassed 18<sup>th</sup> birthday)
3. Juniors may move up to the Intermediate age division when participating on a team that has true intermediates (based on grades listed above) on it. Intermediates may NOT move down to a Junior Team nor move up to the Senior age division. Senior teams must be Senior members ONLY.

## REGISTRATION PERIOD

1. Registration will be conducted on 4HOnline ([v2.4honline.com](https://v2.4honline.com)). *Each member* of a team will be required to register themselves on 4HONline.
2. Regular Registration Period: \$15 per contest entered.
  - a. October 6 - **October 31, 2023 (DEADLINE)**
3. Late Registration: \$15 per contest entered PLUS a **\$25.00 late fee**.
  - a. November 1-3, 2023 **FINAL DEADLINE FOR REGISTRATION**
4. **No refunds** will be given for any District Contest Registrations.

## ADVANCING TO DISTRICT

### Team Contests

1. Team contests do not have a limit on the number of teams that can advance to District with the exception of the following:
  - a. **Food Challenge Contest is limited to two (2) teams per age division per county.**
2. Team Contests that allow individuals will only allow two individuals per age division.
  - a. If a county has three or more individuals entered, those individuals must be combined into a team to compete at District.
3. All team members must be from the same county.

### Individual Contests

1. Individual Contests do not have a limit on the number of participants that can advance to District with the exception of the following:
  - a. **Food Show is limited to 1 individual per age division, per category, per county.**

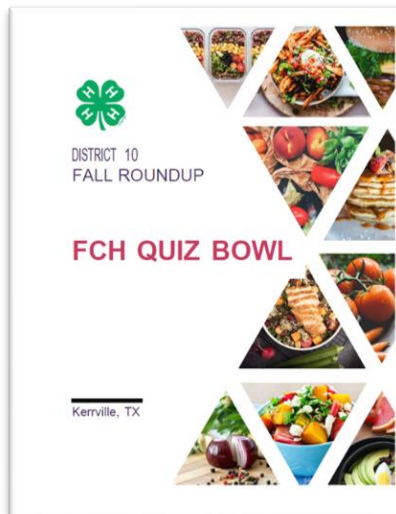

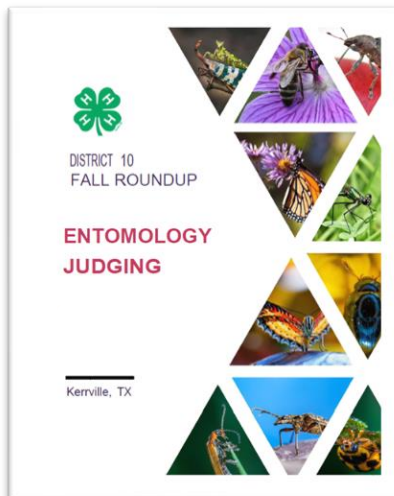
