2025 Major Show Entry: November 1st – November 8th – DEADLINE November 8th

Entries will be accepted at the Bexar County Extension Office from November 1st to November 8th from 8:30 am – 11:30 am and 1:00 pm – 4:30 pm. Appointments will also be available on November 1st, 5th and 7th.

- **ALL entries (Fort Worth Stock Show, San Angelo Stock Show, Texas Elite, Rodeo Austin, Rio Grande Valley Livestock Show, Houston Livestock Show, Hill District Grandstand and San Antonio Stock Show and Rodeo) will be due November 8th. Any entries submitted AFTER November 8th will incur a \$100 fee.**
- **You are responsible for doing your own entries for Hill District Grandstand and San Antonio Stock Show and Rodeo online.**
- **If you are needing a San Antonio Premium Pass, please notify Kennedy Green by October 31st. They are \$500 each.**

 - **Breeding animals:** Exhibitors are encouraged to bring registration papers.
 - **Cash or check ONLY** to cover entry fee. Make checks payable to Bexar 4-H Fund
- **TEAM COMPETITIONS (INCLUDING SAN ANTONIO) – DEADLINE November 8th**
 - 1 Team coach/parent will bring all money and forms for registration to the Extension office.
 - **ALL TEAM MEMBERS MUST BE LISTED AT THE TIME OF REGISTRATION.**
 - The person completing team registration will need all the required information for each team member at the time of registration.
 - Please be aware of show Team Limits
 - All competitions with team limits will be determined by county qualifying contests.

2024 – 2025 Texas 4-H Opportunity Scholarship (SCHOLARSHIPS) (RESOURCES)

The Texas 4-H Opportunity Scholarships are awarded each year to applicants based on their academic record, 4-H experience, and financial need (for scholarships for which it is a required criterion). The Texas 4-H Opportunity Scholarship Program is conducted by the Texas 4-H Youth Development Foundation. Over 200 academically competitive scholarships will be awarded in the 2025 Texas 4-H Opportunity Scholarship Program ranging in amounts from \$1,000 to \$30,000. No scholarship recipient whose award is based on this application process will receive less than \$1,000. For the majority of the total scholarships and scholarship funds available, participation in a livestock show is not a requirement for consideration.

Texas 4-H Foundation Grant Applications OPEN (RULES & GUIDELINES)

Texas 4-H Foundation Grant Applications are now open!The purpose of this grant program is to provide funding to County and District 4-H Programming. These funds may be used to enhance (equipment purchases, education/training, events, etc.) existing 4-H programs and projects or to start new 4-H programs or projects.

- The deadline to submit applications is **11:59 pm on December 31st**.
- You must submit the application through the online portal.
- The application will ask for a description of how the funds will be used, what problem the funds will be used to address, about your intended audience, for a budget, and how you will evaluate the program.
- You will be notified if you did or did not receive a grant in February 2025.
- If you receive a grant, the funds must be used by August 31, 2026. You must email a one-page summary including 3 pictures to bailee.wright@ag.tamu.edu by August 31, 2026. More information regarding the summary will be sent to those who receive the grant.

New This Year

Each exhibitor is now responsible for entering their own entries into ShoWorks online and paying for them directly. Clubs/Chapters are no longer required to collect and pay for the entire group. However, if a club chooses to do so, they still can, but they will be responsible to manage the check-in and auction account. Clubs can view entries and will need to approve entries made under their name.

Why the Change?

1. The majority of Clubs/Chapters requested this change, particularly regarding the handling of funds.
2. More importantly, ShoWorks now offers new features that require exhibitors to log into their accounts. These features include:
 - Online check-in at the show, including submitting weight cards
 - Uploading photos for the auction
 - Managing auction add-ons

We must emphasize the importance of exhibitors remembering their passwords to complete these tasks above.

Entry Process

Exhibitors familiar with ShoWorks can begin submitting entries today (October 1st). A training video will be available this weekend for those unfamiliar with ShoWorks. If you are new to the platform, we highly recommend watching the video before submitting your entry.

We suggest creating entries using "Passport" instead of "Exhibitor."

Excused Absence Policy and Procedures – [UIL Side-By-Side Guidelines Link](#)

• **Process steps**

1. The Bexar County AgriLife Extension Service Office will use registrations to send excused absence requests and academic eligibility checks directly to the school for all contests.
 - Should you register for a contest as a 4-H member through judgingcard or other third-party registration system, it is your responsibility to notify the county extension office in a timely manner.
2. Schools will complete the eligibility check and determine if excused absences will be granted
 - Bexar County 4-H staff works hard yearly to maintain adjunct faculty agreements with all 19 school districts in Bexar County to facilitate these requests.
 - Excused absence requests will include all days you might be at a contest, show, or trip under the supervision of a Bexar County Extension employee or a 4-H volunteer.
3. If there is an issue with the academic eligibility check, Kevin will call you directly.
 - If you wish to confirm the academic check, you are welcome to contact the Bexar County Texas A&M AgriLife Extension Service Office.

• **Items of Note**

1. The request for an excused absence from our office is simply a request. Schools have the right to decline the request at their discretion.
 - If the request is denied, the family must work out the issue with the school directly
2. 4-H excused absences are governed by UIL side-by-side guidelines and adhere to the same rules used for school athletic, academic, or extracurricular activities.
3. Excused absences are limited to 10 district absences/5 post-district absences/2 additional max.
 - Distribution of these days is up to the schools and is not controlled by the Bexar County AgriLife Extension Service Office
 - We recommend that for competitions that might require multiple days (e.g., major stock shows), a parent or other family member handles the arrival and early care of the animal, if possible, and the exhibitor participates in the final show prep and active showing of the animal to minimize days needed for excused absences.
 - **The Bexar County Texas A&M AgriLife Extension Service does not condone the care or preparation of show animals at a show by third-party individuals who are not members of the exhibitor's immediate family without a member of the exhibitor's family present at all times.**
